Context and Challenges for Early Hebrew Believers

- [Written around 65-69 AD, just before the destruction of the temple](#)
- [Audience faced persecution from Romans and pressure from Jewish community](#)
- [Some leaders and teachers were turning away from faith](#)
- [Radical message: Jesus as divine Messiah, difficult for Jewish believers to accept](#)

Warnings Against Drifting Away

- [Hebrews 2:1-4 emphasizes paying careful attention to the message heard](#)
- [Encourages remembering the reality of one's conversion experience](#)
- [Highlights God's confirmation through signs, wonders, and gifts of the Holy Spirit](#)

Jesus' Humanity and Role as High Priest

- [Jesus made "lower than angels" to experience human suffering and temptation](#)
- [His humanity allows Him to be a merciful and faithful high priest](#)
- [Emphasizes Jesus' ability to help believers in temptation due to His own experiences](#)

Humanity's Place in God's Plan

- [Draws from Psalm 8 to show humanity's original role in creation](#)
- [Describes how Jesus restores and elevates humanity's position through His sacrifice](#)
- [Presents a narrative of fall and redemption that was challenging for Jewish believers](#)

Family Imagery in Salvation

- [Jesus not ashamed to call believers brothers and sisters](#)
- [Emphasizes the intimate, familial relationship between Christ and believers](#)
- [Contrasts with fear and slavery to death before knowing Christ](#)

- Continue to study and discuss subsequent chapters of Hebrews
- Reflect on personal experiences of God's faithfulness and conversion
- Apply the chapter's teachings on resisting temptation and not drifting from faith
